

A time to celebrate - The coming together of Trinity Methodist Church and St. Andrews Church, Shifnal.

On Easter Sunday we celebrated the coming together of Trinity Methodist and St. Andrews churches, Shifnal, signing a document that puts the two churches into Partnership. This culminates 20 months of exploring what this means, and which the Bishop and the Chair need to ratify this on Pentecost Sunday. However we believe this is a new age for our churches going forward.

This will mean that usually we shall worship together at St. Andrew's, and use Trinity spaces for outreach and occasionally for different types of services, such as Messy Church and HeartSpace. We shall continue to maintain our own building for a while, with a Church Council being responsible for property and finance, but in time we hope to become an LEP (Local Ecumenical Project) when the properties will become legally under one PCC/Church Council.

The Trinity facilities are desperately needed for St. Andrew's to maintain their work, while the St. Andrew's church is needed to house both our congregations.

This is an exciting if unknown future for our churches. We travel together on a journey that we don't know the outcome of, but we believe it to be the best result for our two churches and the fact that we are doing so much of the same. Please pray for us as we continue on this journey together.


